Holiday Greetings from Wildwood Ranch! I hope that everyone is looking forward to a great Christmas Break as well as a relaxing New Year with family and friends. Once again, it's that time of year to start planning for riding lessons and sign up for camp. The horses and I are very excited!

Enclosed is the 2012 horse camp brochure. I hope everyone can make it. To secure your space at camp you must complete the enclosed "Wildwood Ranch 2012 Horse Camp Application" and return it with a \$25.00 deposit. We cannot accommodate every student at the residential camp, so act as soon as possible if your child desires to participate. Lessons will begin on **May 5**. The classes will be scheduled as shown below. Please call me if you are not sure at what level you should be placed. The price of lessons is \$15.00 each week. Lessons are 1 1/2 hours and include grooming, saddling and basic horse care.

To sign up for lessons complete the enclosed "2012 Horse Lessons" application and return it to the Wildwood Ranch office with a \$10.00 registration fee.

- 9:00 - 10:30 Intermediate - This class is for students that can control the horse at the walk and trot and are learning to canter.
- 10:30 - 12:00 First Class and Advanced - This class helps riders that already know how to walk, trot and canter to learn new skills that improve both the horse and rider. Dressage training is emphasized.
- 1:00 - 2:30 Elementary - This class is for new and beginning riders who want to learn the basics of horse riding and care. Students learn to walk, trot and basic control.

Barn clean-up is on **April 21 from 10:00 AM - 3:00 PM**. Come and help out...bring work gloves and wear old clothes! Lunch will be provided. There is even a Spring Horsemanship Retreat scheduled for that weekend (**April 20-21, 2012**) if you are interested. Watch the website for details or call the camp office.
